Step 1: Competition Registration.

The online registration system will be open from **August 16th** to **September 15th, 2021**. The registration link is www.iwuf.org/registration.

Step 2: Download the APP.

The APP can be accessible and downloaded through the online registration system after **August 16th, 2021**.

Step 3: Competition Video Uploading.

Upload Competition Video through the APP, please follow the guideline to upload the athletes' competition video.

Step 4: Judging

All independent technical officials (International Judges) of the virtual competition will be recommended to IWUF Secretariat by IWUF Judges' Committee (JC).

Step 5: Broadcast.

The specific broadcast channel will be announced through the IWUF website in due course.

Step 6: Appeal


