THE WORLD GAMES 2025 - WUSHU TAOLU

REGULATIONS

The 12th World Games is the official Multi-Sport Game which is hosted by the International World Games Association (IWGA). Most competitions contained in the General Competition Schedule will take place from August 7th to 17th, 2025 in Chengdu, China. Wushu has been officially included into the sport program. The Wushu competition is comprised of both Taolu and Sanda disciplines. According to the IWGA General Program, the Wushu Taolu Competition will be held from August 5th to 10th and Sanda Competition will be held from August 7th to 13th.

1. DATE & PLACE

The Wushu Taolu Competition of The World Games 2025 (TWG 2025) will be held from August 5th - 10th, 2025 in Chengdu, China.

2. VENUES

- 2.1. Competition Venue: Hi-Tech Zone Sports Center Gymnasium
- 2.2. Training Venue: Hi-Tech Zone Sports Center Gymnasium
- 2.3. Address: No.313 Jilong Road, Hi-Tech Zone, 610041, Chengdu, China.

3. COMPETITION EVENTS

- 3.1. Men's:
 - Changquan, Daoshu and Gunshu Combined.
 - Nanquan and Nangun Combined.
 - Taijiqian and Taijijian Combined.
- 3.2. Women's:
 - Changquan, Jianshu and Qiangshu Combined.
 - Nanquan and Nandao Combined.
 - Taijiqian and Taijijian Combined.

4. QUOTA

- 4.1. 27 male athletes and 27 female athletes.
- 4.2. 9 athletes for each combined event under Article C.
- 4.3. The last unused quota position(s) will be reallocated by the International Wushu Federation (IWUF).

5. QUALIFICATIONS

- 5.1. The following athletes competing the events under Article C qualify for TWG 2025 - Wushu Taolu competition. All qualified athletes are listed in Appendix II.
 - The 1st - 6th place athletes whose combined score rank from the 16th World Wushu Championships.
 - The 1st place athletes whose combined score rank from the World Games Series 2024 Hong Kong.

- Two (2) Wild Cards of each combined event under Article C will be allocated by the IWUF.
- 5.2. In any combined event, if an athlete gave up the place, the place given up by the athlete will be seated by the athlete in the same combined event according to the combined score ranking in descending order.

6. PARTICIPATION METHODS

- 6.1. Each qualified athlete may only participate within the event he or she has qualified for.
- 6.2. Each athlete should bring along with him/her a valid Health Certificate (including electrocardiogram (ECG), pulse and blood pressure) issued within 30 days prior to the start of the competition signed by a qualified doctor and a Life Accidental Injury Insurance Certificate. All athletes are required to submit a completed and signed waiver of liabilities form.
- 6.3. Each qualified athlete must be submitted to the IWUF by the IWUF Member Federations/Associations.

7. COMPETITION METHODS

- 7.1. Unless otherwise stated within these regulations, the competition will be conducted in accordance with the "IWUF Wushu Taolu Competition Rules and Judging Methods (2024)". The Rules and Methods may be interpreted solely at the discretion of the IWUF. In case of any disagreement in the interpretation of the rules, the English version shall prevail.
- 7.2. Within a single routine, an athlete may register and perform the same Difficulty Jump Movement at most two (2) times; however, the Degree of Difficulty Connection for these jumps may not be repeated (e.g. within a single optional routine an athlete may register and perform Xuàn Fēng Jiǎo 360° (Tornado Kick 360°) at most two (2) times, but the Degree of Difficulty Connection for each Tornado Kick 360° must be different).
- 7.3. In Changquan-type events, Difficulty Jump Movement: 323B, 323C, 324B, 324C and 353C must be connected to the Degree of Difficulty Connection Content as stipulated in the Rules table 10-3-7 when landing.
- 7.4. In Nanquan-type events, Difficulty Jump Movement: 323B, 323C, 324B and 324C must be connected to the Degree of Difficulty Connection Content as stipulated in the Rules table 10-3-8 when landing.
- 7.5. In Taijiquan-type events, Difficulty Jump Movement: 323B, 323C, 324B and 324C must be connected to the Degree of Difficulty Connection Content as stipulated in the Rules table 10-3-9 when landing.
- 7.6. All athletes are required to execute their optional routine's relevant compulsory/mandatory techniques as stipulated in the rules. Failure to do so will result in deductions as stated in the rules.
- 7.7. Accompanying music is required for Taijiquan and Taijijian routines which must be supplied by the athletes themselves. Failure to do so will result in deductions as stated in the rules.

8. COSTUMES & EQUIPMENT

- 8.1. All athletes must wear wushu competition costumes and use the equipment in compliance with the rules during all events.
- 8.2. The costumes and equipment must be brought and prepared by the athletes themselves.

9. PLACING & AWARD

Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the athletes ranked the top three (3) of each individual combined event respectively.

10. ENTRIES

- 10.1. All Teams must confirm their final entry athletes before **March 15th, 2025 (Beijing Time)**.
- 10.2. All athletes' Degree of Difficulty and Compulsory/Mandatory Techniques must be submitted through the IWUF Online Registration System before **July 28th, 2025 (Beijing Time)**.
- 10.3. IWUF Online Registration System: TBC

11. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

- 11.1. International Technical Officials (ITOs)
The Jury of Appeals and all judges shall be appointed by the IWUF.
- 11.2. National Technical Officials (NTOs)
The National Technical Officials shall be appointed by the Organizing Committee of TWG 2025.

12. TECHNICAL MEETING

The Technical Meeting for team managers and coaches will take place at 9:00 A.M. (Beijing Time) on August 7th, 2025, during which all matters related to the competition will be announced. Each team should send one to two (1-2) representative(s) to attend this meeting.

13. DRAWING - LOTS

The drawing-lots of TWG 2025 will be conducted after the Technical Meeting on August 7th, 2025. Each team should send one to two (1-2) representative(s) to attend this activity. The Jury of Appeals will draw on behalf of the teams that are unable to send a representative to attend.

14. DOPING CONTROL

- 14.1. Doping control will be conducted during TWG 2025. According to the requirements of the IWGA and World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), the IWGA is authorized to test qualified athletes from 6 months prior to TWG 2025 Opening Ceremony, including other IWGA sanctioned events such as TWG Series.
- 14.2. WADA certified education courses are mandatory to participate in TWG 2025 for athletes, medical personnel and the team coach in team sports.

15. RESPONSIBILITY OF MEMBER FEDERATIONS

National/Territorial Federations (NFs) are responsible for their officials, coaches, athletes, and observers adhering to the IWUF and to all relevant rules established by the IWUF and the Organizing Committee. NFs should ensure that their participants hold themselves to the highest standards in all their actions during the event.

- 15.1. Fundamental Principles
All NFs' team members participating in TWG 2025 must observe and respect the IWUF constitution, rules, regulations, and representatives. Individuals deemed to have acted against the IWUF, its principles, interests or purpose may be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation.
- 15.2. Attitude of Athletes and Coaches
The athletes will compete under the responsibility of their NFs. NFs are fully responsible regarding the general attitude and comportment of their athletes. Coaches should respect the judging panel and all complaints must be conducted in

accordance with competition procedures. Athletes and Coaches should comply with the IWUF Code of Ethics. Any act against the IWUF judging panel may be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation and/or competition results.

15.3. Image of Athletes

Each NF is responsible for obtaining the rights for the IWUF to use its athletes' images at the discretion of the IWUF for promotional purposes in all forms.

15.4. Insurance

Each NF is fully and sole responsible for insuring its athletes against injury and third-party risk (public liability) during the period of TWG 2025. The IWUF and the Organizing Committee are not responsible in part or in whole of the said liability.

16. PASSPORT & VISA REQUIREMENTS

16.1. All TWG 2025 participants must hold their valid passports, to ensure as few complications during visa application and travel as possible. It is suggested that all participants' passports are valid for at least six (6) months following their final day of travel.

16.2. Teams that require visa invitation letters should state their requests to the Organizing Committee of TWG 2025 before **April 23rd, 2025 (Beijing Time)**. It is essential for getting the VISA invitation letter in time.

16.3. Due to the frequent updating of the visa-free policy country list, the Visa Policy will be provided by IWGA in February 2025. In the meantime, queries can be sent to: participantservices@theworldgames2025.com and visa@theworldgames.com.

17. ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORTATION

17.1. The Organizing Committee of TWG 2025 is responsible for all qualified Taolu athletes' accommodation, catering and local transport within Chengdu, China, from August 5th to 10th, 2025.

17.2. Athletes and ITOs in quota will be allocated in double room.

17.3. The accommodation fees of all team officials shall be borne by the Teams themselves. The payment policy details will be announced in due course.
